



#### EBacc

#### What is it?

The EBacc is a set of subjects at GCSE that keeps young people's options open for further study and future careers. The EBacc is: •English language and literature •maths •the sciences •geography or history •a language- French or Spanish

Secondary schools are measured on the number of pupils that take GCSEs in these core subjects. Schools are also measured on how well their pupils do in these subjects.


#### The EBacc at Ferndown

However, at FUS we do not constrain our students' choice with pathways or enforced options outside of core provision, however, we actively encourage routes such as the EBacc and we make this option available to all students, regardless of ability, within the school. We also do not constrain option choices such as creative subjects, however we will interview those students who we think may be narrowing their curriculum at an early stage.
